### **ACLEI to investigate security breach**

The Integrity Commissioner, Mr Philip Moss, today announced that the Australian Commission for Law Enforcement Integrity (ACLEI) will investigate an alleged security breach relating to Operation Neath, a joint Commonwealth-State law enforcement investigation which involved the execution of search warrants in New South Wales and Victoria on Tuesday 4 August.

The ACLEI investigation is part of a coordinated response by State and Federal law enforcement and integrity agencies, including the Office of Police Integrity (Victoria).

ACLEI's focus will relate to the involvement, if any, of members of the Australian Federal Police in the alleged security breach.

ACLEI will not make further comment at this stage.
