ACLEI FOI 20/16—Cost of investigation into Ramzi Jabbour

**Parameters** The estimated cost incurred by the Australian Commission for Law Enforcement Integrity (ACLEI) in the corruption investigation of former Australian Federal Police (AFP) Deputy Commissioner Ramzi Jabbour that was referred to the Commonwealth Director of Public Prosecutions (CDPP) in 2019.

That investigation was conducted jointly with the AFP. The amount provided concerns ACLEI's costs.

**Methodology** The cost to ACLEI of the investigation has been estimated by combining the following amounts:

- Estimation of employee salaries attributable to the investigation to the point of referral; and
- Actual costs incurred through discrete investigative activities (e.g. use of particular investigative tools and ancillary activities such as travel).

**Cost** \$107,345.30
